### 11. **Radar Speed Signs**

Members have been considering the introduction of Radar Speed Signs in the Parish in an attempt to effect motorist speed. After research the Evolis Radar Speed sign is recommended, as used in our neighbouring parish. The product brochure is enclosed, with claims that there is proven positive influence over driver behaviour that make the roads safer.

Members are asked to resolve whether to purchase one or more of the speed signs.

## **12. Restricting Dogs on Land – Carr Lane**

In 2017 West Lancashire Borough Council drew up a Public Space Protection Order which placed certain restrictions on land to restrict dog fouling and potential dog attacks. The full details can be found via the following link:

The Borough Council now think it is appropriate to include Carr Lane fields as one where dogs should be kept on a lead. This reduces the chances of any dog attacks and should reduce the amount of fouling on our site, as dogs are closer to their owners.

The Borough Council is commencing a public consultation and are asking the Parish Council to comment and hopefully support the proposals. Both Tarleton Corinthians Football Club and Tarleton Cricket Club support the introduction of this measure.

## **13. Parish Council Representation on the WLBC Standards Committee**

The WLBC Standards Committee's membership includes Borough Councillors and two Parish Council representatives. WLBC would like to invite Parish Councils to submit the name of one of its Members that they would wish to see appointed to serve on the Standards Committee. The Member nominated should not be a Borough Councillor and ideally should not be a close friend of any Member or officer of the Borough Council. The nominee will also be required to prepare a brief personal profile.

Members are asked to resolve to forward any nomination as a candidate from this Council.

## **14. The Gravel, Mere Brow – Culvert Damage**

The culvert that deals with surface water off The Gravel, Mere Brow, was identified by Lancashire CC Engineers at least two years ago as having collapsed under the road. Nothing has been done and recent heavy rains have once again highlighted the urgent need for repair. The road was originally marked at the site of the collapse but this marking has disappeared over time. Members are asked to resolve to lobby the County Council to remedy this problem.
