The Clerk reported on:

- a) Revised plans for the pavilion storage extension had been produced. The Clerk is liaising with Paul Higham (Cricket Club);
- b) Natural England is hosting a drop-in day on 22 November 2017 at Hesketh Bank Community Centre regarding England's Coast Path – entitled "Improvements to public access along the coast – Cleveleys to Pier Head", Liverpool. All were welcome to go. The Clerk would be attending;
- c) Website: The matter is still under review;
- d) The Clerk would be meeting a Research Consultant from Knight, Kavanagh & Page as part of a project being undertaken by WLBC into Open Space in the Borough;
- e) One of the budgeted projects for the current year was to install additional CCTV cameras and security lighting at Carr Lane. The Clerk shared quotes obtained from our preferred suppliers. Members agreed that the Clerk should proceed on the basis of those quotes.
- f) Another budgeted project was to provide a hard surface / grass parking at Carr Lane between the trees by the main pitch. Quotes have been requested;

- g) The meeting with Holy Trinity Tarleton Parochial Church Council, as they sought financial support for their efforts to secure additional land adjacent to the existing village graveyard, has yet to take place due to availability issues with Church officials. The Clerk and Cllr Latham will attend.
- h) The Clerk had attended a meeting with Lawn Tennis Association officials to explore the possibility of financial support towards the provision of tennis courts. 50% funding of projects is available. A meeting with Acland Bracewell to discuss land issues was needed. The Clerk / Cllr Bryan are trying to organise a meeting;
- i) Christmas Lights: 24 solar tree lights had been ordered on a rental basis. The newly purchased lights and our current stock should be erected soon by the County Council. The new lights needed additional electrical fittings which the County Council has agreed to fit.
