2019/031 Minutes of the last meeting

2019/032 Clerks Report (for information only)

- a) The use of the area known as "Scout Field" by the Football Club has caused some debate with both the guides and scouts querying the use. The Clerk will speak to the Football Club;
- b) A full Health and Safety audit of the Carr Lane facility is to be undertaken by an independent expert. The Play Area annual independent review will take place in August.
